We are underway at Llandrindod, the green has been handed over to the WLB President Heulwen Morgan by the President of Llandrindod, Eddie Williams.

The first session is underway with the over 55 rinks, both Ladies and Men and the mixed pairs quarter finals.



First session coming to a close and first results in are the mixed pairs quarter finals where Tenby beat Maesteg 27-10, Resolven beat Barry Athletic 21-10, Llandrindod Wells beat Llanbradach 20-19 and Harlequins beat Llanidloes 20-11. In the semi final later Tenby play Resolven and Llandrindod play Harlequins.
