<u>RULES:-</u>												
1	The competition is open to men and ladies under the age of 25											
2	Each team to consist of 9 players plus one reserve who can be played at the Team Managers discretion											
3	Dress Code:- Whites / County or Club kit											
4	Play in section games shall be 15 ends or 1 hour and 45 minutes											
5	Number of bowls per player:- Pairs - 4 bowls, Triples:- 3 bowls, Fours:- 2 bowls.											
6	Two trial ends of two bowls for each player shall be allowed in each round											
7	In the section games, normal playing conditions apply except visits to the head are restricted to one only per team per end by the skips.											
8	In the section games, winners of the tie are the team that scores most shots, two points awarded for each rink won, 1 point for a drawn rink, 6 points for an overall win, making a maximum available total of 12 points in each game. The winners of each section shall qualify for the final. The winning team in each section shall be the team with the most points, if this is tied then it shall be the team with the highest shot differential (shots for minus shots against) which qualifies, if this is tied then the finalist shall be the team with the most shots for, if this is also tied then it shall be the team that took most points in the game against the team they are tied with, and if that is still tied then the teams play a one end decider with team with most shots scored qualifying for the final (if tied after one end play another until winner emerges). The Winner of the final shall be the team who scores the most shots											
9	The Final will be played over 15 ends (after two trial ends have been played) with normal match rules applying and no restrictions.											
10	In the case of any dispute or confusion over interpretation of these rules, the decision of the assistant Secretary is final and irrevocable.
